
- Saturday Evening Session 8:00p.m. - 9:15 p.m. (for members age 18 and over).

Dear members of the Saskatoon Saskatchewan Stake,

Today the First Presidency of the Church released a statement encouraging members of the Church to take specific measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19, including wearing of masks and getting vaccinated.

Although we respect personal agency and do not wish to pass judgment, we ask and strongly encourage you to consider the counsel and example of our Prophet, Seer, and Revelator, President Russell M. Nelson and proceed with getting vaccinated. As a physician myself, I add my witness and advice that vaccination saves lives, dramatically reduces death, hospitalizations and serious infections, is very safe, and our only chance to end this pandemic that has ravaged the globe for the past 20 months, and will continue to mutate and infect as long as it has ready hosts.

This weekend, as physical distancing will not likely be possible in the Stake Center, I encourage you, particularly those that are not vaccinated, to wear a mask during the conference proceedings. It is not mandatory, but out of humility and love for our neighbours, friends, family, and children, I highly recommend you to do so.

As your Stake President, I love you and am deeply invested in your well-being. I am grateful for the opportunity that we have to minister to each other by taking the steps to protect each other.

Dear Bishops and Branch Presidents:

Over the past several months the Stake Young Women's and Aaronic Priesthood Presidencies have been meeting to discuss the youth of the Stake in the Aaronic Priesthood and Young Women's (APYW) Committee. With the COVID-19 Pandemic continuing the impact our lives the APYW under the direction of President Prete have been focused on the engagement and spirituality of the youth of the Stake. Specifically, we have been focusing our discussions 2 primary topics:

- 1) How are the youth coping with the current pandemic restrictions, and;
- 2) How can the Stake APWY better support the Branch Presidents, Bishops, Young Women's Leaders in the Stake?

The APYW Committee is proposing to hold a **Stake Youth Council** on **February 9th** at **7:00pm** with Youth representative from each Unit to discuss how they are doing and what we can do to strengthen and engage them during the COVID pandemic. We have selected 3 questions to focus the discussion:

- **How are the Youth doing during this time of limited interaction with each other and Church programs?**
- **What are the Youth and Unit leaders doing to support them during this time?**
- **What support is needed from the Stake to engage or re-engage the youth?**

During this difficult time, it is important that combine our effort to fortify and strengthen our youth so they can withstand the challenges of this ever changing and uncertain period of time. With your assistance we hope to ensure all youth are supported and will feel the love of the Savior.

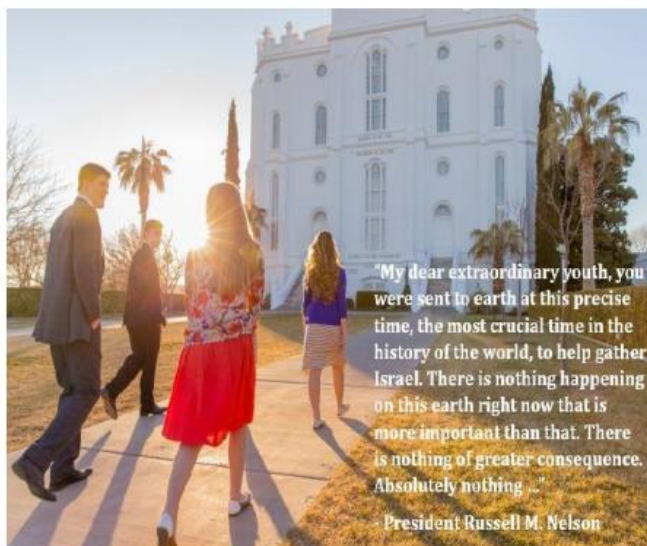

Faith Leaders Update – May 25

Hello faith leaders,

The Faith Leaders' Working Group met with our government liaisons again today. As you know, the Saskatchewan Re-opening Roadmap will begin Step 1 on Sunday May 30. We have sought clarification on a number of details raised by you or another faith leader. Here is a summary of the upcoming changes:

In Step 1, beginning Sunday, May 30:

- **maximum capacity of a place of worship will be increased to 30% of seating capacity, with a maximum of 150 people in the entire facility.**
- 2 metre distancing, masking, sanitizing, and contact tracing will continue to be required.
- sharing food or drink is prohibited in Step 1.
- other non-worship gatherings will be allowed to a maximum of **30 people**.
- non-worship gatherings held concurrently with a worship service are allowed but the total number of people in the worship service and additional gathering may not exceed 150 people.
- non-essential travel is not recommended outside Saskatchewan

In Step 2, beginning June 20, there will be few changes affecting places of worship:

- maximum capacity will remain 30% of seating capacity, with a maximum of 150 people in the entire facility
- 2 metre distancing, masking, sanitizing, and contact tracing will continue to be required.
- sharing food or drink is prohibited in Step 2.
- other non-worship gatherings will be allowed to a maximum of **150 people**.
- non-worship gatherings held concurrently with a worship service are allowed but the total number of people in the worship service and additional gathering may not exceed 150 people.

- non-essential travel is not recommended outside Saskatchewan.

Step 3 is anticipated in mid-July. In Step 3 most restrictions will be lifted. There will be no limits on capacity, food and drink will be permitted, physical distancing and contact tracing will not be required. It is expected that masks and sanitizing will be advised for some time, but the public health emergency will end and the public health orders will be lifted soon after Step 3 begins.

Due to the continuing high infection rates in both Alberta and Manitoba, travel will not be recommended even in Step 3. The entire SK Roadmap is contingent on the continuing decline in infection rates. Please continue to cooperate with public health authorities and encourage vaccination.

COVID-19 Corona virus

Following our local guidelines as well as church recommendations this was how we handled the restrictions to help our members keep safe when we were able to meet together in our church buildings again.

Saskatoon Saskatchewan Stake Pandemic activity guideline summary

Updated March 30, 2021

“We believe in being subject to kings, presidents, rulers, and magistrates, in obeying, honoring, and sustaining the law.”

- 12th Article of Faith

“Gather ...together oft” (Alma 6:6)

• **Selected guidelines for Worship Services (Sunday meetings only)**

- Masks – everyone except while speaking from podium (in this case, must be 3m from anyone if unmasked)
- Maximum 30 per cent of building capacity or 150 people, whichever is less
- Minimum 2m between households
- required to collect and maintain a list of people that are present within their facilities for any purposes. Contact details must include date, time, name, address, and phone number or email address (Maintain list for 30 days)

Classes (SS, EQ, RS, Prim, etc.)

- groups no larger than 30 as long as physical distancing can be maintained
- No food or beverage
- Attendees to remain seated except for entering and exiting, as well as using the washroom.
- If tables are being used, there must not be more than four per table.

High risk activities

- All physical contact, such as handshaking or passing objects between individuals, is not permitted.
- Microphones cannot be shared between individuals due to the difficulty of cleaning and disinfecting these devices. Minimize the number of attendees providing readings or performing other activities that would require the use of a microphone.
- While choirs and singing by congregation members are permitted in places of worship, caution is advised as singing is a high-risk activity.

Activities

- Masks, no physical contact or touching of common objects, physical distancing maintained
- Outdoor if possible
- No food or drink, water fountains must be closed
- No sports in church buildings. Cultural halls (gyms) may not be used for exercise or physical activity\

Building Care

- Frequent cleaning of the church building
- Empty all trash receptacles regularly
- Extra care to high touch areas

Come, Listen to a Prophet's Voice: The Messages of President Nelson

From the beginning of the year to the end, Church President Russell M. Nelson's messages focused on the Savior of the world. The most recent updates (detailed below) were published today online and in the Gospel Library app. This handbook has been prepared under the direction of the First Presidency and Quorum of the Twelve Apostles.

The General Handbook is the result of unifying Handbook 1 (for stake presidents and bishops) and Handbook 2 (for all leaders) into one volume. The first chapters were published in February 2020, with subsequent updates in July and December of that year and March and August of 2021. Completion in other languages will come in 2022.

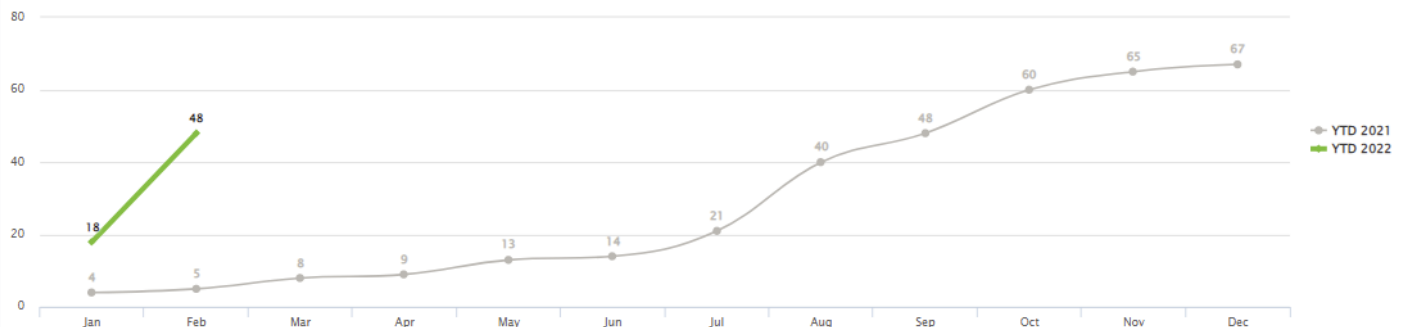

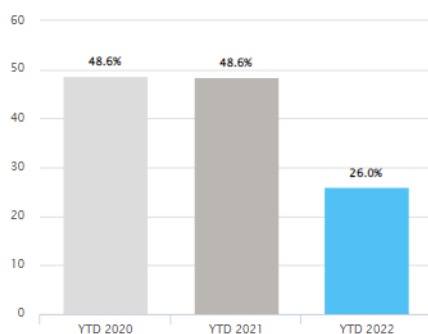

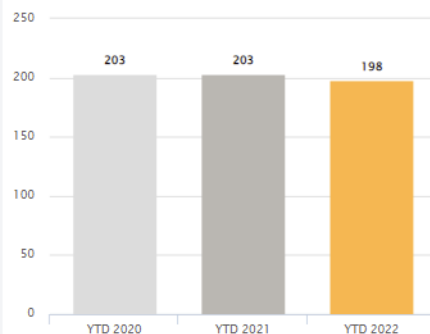


First Four Generations of Ancestors in the Tree

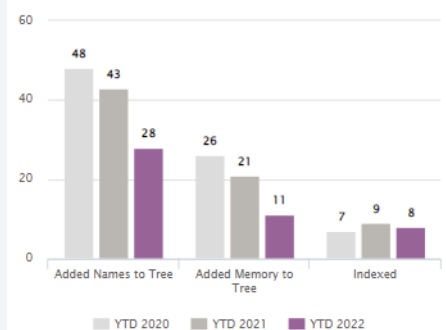
